Important Letter

Over this past year St. Mark's has assisted local families with school supplies and have provided many who are in need with necessary food and clothing throughout the year. We support the work of the Sisters of Mercy in their missions in Peru and we have sponsored refugee families. We have partnered with local nonprofits like Romero House and KV Oasis. We feel blessed to have been able to do these things but we need your help to continue our work. Our operating costs are quickly outpacing our regular weekly collections. Our current weekly expenses average \$450 - \$500 more than our regular collections Together, we can continue to make a difference. An important letter will be published and available next week through email distribution or copies available at the entrances in the church indicating how we as a parish can continue to make a difference at St. Mark's and in the community.
