Some keys must be avoided completely! Our new piano is expected to arrive in time to enhance our celebration of The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ on November 24. You will notice a richness in our music, as the pianists will now be able to play the music as it is written, being fully confident in the instrument they are playing. The piano is being purchased with funds from St. Marks Building Fund. Many thanks to all who continue to support our Building Fund! In future, we plan to initiate a fund-raising campaign, in order offset some of the cost of our new piano.

St. Mark's Receives a Crucifix

As Catholics, the crucified Christ is at the centre of our faith. For this reason, the teaching of the Roman Catholic Church in the General Instruction of the Roman Missal specifies that a crucifix should be located in the sanctuary, and that it must be large enough to be visible to the faithful during the celebration of the Mass. St. Mark's has been blessed to receive a suitable crucifix. which formerly graced the sanctuary of St. Peter's Church in Saint John. St. Peter's has been closed. By accepting this gift, we will be able to preserve an important piece of art and to acknowledge that community, many of whom now attend St. Mark's. This does mean that the Risen Christ currently in our sanctuary must be moved. The figures of the Holy Family will also be moved from the sanctuary, so that our attention is focused on the crucifix-the sign of Jesus' sacrificial love for us. Because of upcoming renovations planned in our church, the figures of the Risen Christ and the Holy Family may need to be temporarily placed in storage, while the suitability of alternative locations in our church are confirmed.
